Green Party of Virginia 25 Signature Challenge Packet

Overview

In order to get on the ballot in Virginia, the Green Party needs 5,000 signatures, with at least 200 in each Congressional district. We sued the state to eliminate this requirement in light of the pandemic, but they refused – only reducing that number in half to 2,500. This is not an easy task for our party and we need all the volunteer we can get to make this happen! That's why we are asking volunteers to take the 25 signature challenge, getting at least 25 signatures by August 10, to ensure there is a real, progressive choice on the ballot this November!

That's just 25 signatures in about 25 days! If we get just 100 people to take this challenge, we will meet our goal!

Instructions

Thank you for helping us with ballot access this year! This is an important endeavor. To get started view the guide below and then download and complete the petition.

Steps to Petition

- 1. Download and print either the letter size or legal size petition, front and back. Both forms are inside this packet!
- 2. Gather signatures from registered VA voters. They have to sign and then print, which is backwards from most forms, so be sure to point this out to them. Each petition form can only be used to gather signatures from ONE county or independent city. A complete list of all independent cities and towns is inside this packet! You will need to print a separate for for each city/county your signers might be from.
- 3. Get the form notarized by a notary at a bank, library, or county/town clerk's office. You can normally get the forms notarized for free! Do NOT sign the form on the back until you are with the notary.

4. Mail the forms to P.O. Box 845, Blacksburg, VA 24063 by August 10.

5. Feel good knowing that you are the reason there will be a REAL progressive choice on the ballot this November!

Petitioning During COVID

Some volunteers may not feel comfortable gathering signatures from strangers in public due to the current COVID-19 pandemic. If this applies to you, you can still gather signatures from the friends and family members you DO come into contact with. Just bear in mind that you cannot gather your own signature, so someone else in your household will need to do that!

Things to Keep in Mind

Make copies of the petition form to use when gathering petitions. Remember that copies must be "front and back," but can use either the letter size or the legal size copy. Legal size petitions need to be printed on legal size paper and letter size petitions need to be printed on letter size paper. Don't print legal size

petitions on letter size paper, or vice versa. Petitions printed across two pieces of paper will be rejected by the Virginia Board of Elections (VBE).

You will need to use a separate petition form for registered voters of each locality (county or independent city) in which your signers reside. (Write in the County/City in the place provided on the form.) You CANNOT collect signatures from registered voters from multiple localities on the same form. For example, signers from Manassas and Manassas Park will need to sign separate forms. Make sure you write the name of the locality in which the voter is registered on the appropriate line. Some localities can be confusing. For example, if a voter tells you they are registered in Roanoke, you will need to ask them if they mean Roanoke City or Roanoke County and have them fill out the corresponding petition. For those gathering signatures at home or among friends and family members only due to COVID-19, please note that you cannot witness your own signature. Someone else will need to witness your signature and complete the back of the petition with the notary.

Petitioners themselves must be registered voters in the state of Virginia!

Gathering Petition Signatures for the Green Party of Virginia

Why get signatures?

- We need 2,500 signatures from registered voters to get on the ballot in Virginia.
- 200 have to come from each Congressional district.

Getting Started

- Must be printed on both sides
- Can be either letter or legal size

Where to find Voters

- Go to public events and spaces.
- Host events inviting people to sign and hear more about the Green Party.
- Talk to friends and family.

Getting the Signatures

- Make sure they are registered voters.
- You MUST witness every signature.
- Guide the voter through the process as in the video.
- Make sure they fill in ALL required boxes
- Encourage them to put in the last for of their SSN.

Tips and Tricks

- Make sure voters sign the petition for the county/city for which they are registered.
- Ask everyone!
- Remember, you are a representative of the Green Party; be polite and courteous.

 the notary.

It is not mandatory that it be provided and you may sign the petition without doing so. The Department of Elections, when copying this document for public inspection, must cover the month and day of the date of birth.

How to print this document:

The Petition of Qualified Voters for Electors for President and Vice President form [ELECT-543(P)] is a two-page document (front and back) printed on one piece of 8 ½" x 11" paper.

When you print this form, it should be printed front and back on one 8 ½" x 11" sheet of paper.

If you are unable to print a double-sided print job, you may print two separate pages. However, you must then reproduce/copy the two pages into one page before collecting any signatures. The front of the petition contains line numbers 1 through 4; the back of the form contains line numbers 5 through 9 followed by the AFFIDAVIT.

If you are unable to print or reproduce this form on 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" printed back and front, then call our office at 800-552-9745 or 804-864-8901 and we will be glad to send you a form.

When you submit this form to the appropriate entity, all petition signatures must be originals on the form. No copies of petition signatures will be accepted.
