DIRECTIONS TO MEETING:

From northern Va., follow I-66 W and US-29 S to US 460 near Lynchburg, then east on 460 to Appomattox. Take first exit off 460 at Appomattox onto Confederate Blvd, then right at second light onto Court Street to Main Street. Left on Main, two blocks, Baines on left. Alternately, South on I95 to Richmond, west on VA 76/Powhite Pkwy to VA 288, south to Hull Street Road west, then as from Richmond (below). About 3 /12 hours either way from Fairfax, modulo traffic on I95 south, which is a coin-toss Saturday mornings, and a parking lot on Friday night.

From Front Royal/Winchester, I81 south to I64 east as far as Charlottesville, then US29 south. Continue as from northern VA (above).

From Richmond, take Hull Street Road/US 360 west past Amelia to VA 307, right onto 307 west to US 460. Continue west on US 460 to Appomattox, taking first exit at Appomattox onto Confederate Blvd, through town to Court Street, left on Court Street to Main Street, left on Main to Baines, about 2 blocks. About 2 hours overall from downtown Richmond.

From southeast VA, I64 to Richmond, past downtown then connect to I195 south to VA 76 Powhite Parkway, west to VA 288, south to Hull Street Road/US 360 west, then continue as from

Richmond (above). There are two toll plazas on VA 76, one is 70 cents and the other 75 cents. Tolls may be avoided by going around the city to the south, but at a significant cost of driving time. Alternatively, one may take US 460 from the Norfolk/Suffolk area directly to Appomattox, passing Richmond on the south, but this is a more sedate route with lower speeds and more in-town stops, but the total time will still be c. 3hrs from downtown Norfolk.

From southwest VA, I81 north to Roanoke, east on I581 to Orange Ave./US220/US460 east, past Lynchburg to Appomattox, take first exit at Appomattox onto Confederate Blvd, through town to Court Street, left on Court Street to Main Street, left on Main to Baines, about 2 blocks. About 2 hours overall from downtown Richmond.
